On behalf of the Salt Spring Island Rod and Gun Club I first apologize for the delay in responding to your support, but more importantly, want to sincerely thank you for your support and let you know that because of you and others that have sent contributions, we have been able to keep our club alive and active while fighting our legal battles. Legally speaking, it is still hard to say what has been a win and what has been a loss. One thing for sure, however, is that we now have a stronger club. Ironically, since the move to shut us down, our membership numbers have increased and favourable public support for our cause is now in around the 80% range in a number of different polls.

What we are fighting for matters. For instance, the BC Supreme Court ruling in our case with the Regional District that, essentially, a club cannot be put out of business through bylaws, has set a precedent already used successfully across Canada in about 5 or 6 cases. But our battles are not over and the outcome of those could similarly have far reaching effects. Hopefully there is justice in the legal system.

Regardless of the outcome, your support has been crucial to our Club's survival and has meant much more than just getting the bills paid.
